BAT was established in 1981 to serve and represent the interests of people with autism and their families predominantly in the London Borough of Bromley.

Since that time we have established a Family Support Service which presently helps over 500 families who have a family member with an Autistic Spectrum Disorder. We also run 3 registered homes, 4 supported living flats, a Day Service and a domiciliary support service. Through training and conferences we raise awareness of the needs of people with autism and their families and represent them in a number of different areas.

We maintain a membership who wish to support our aims, objectives and core values. Members will receive Bromley Autistic Trust's annual report and accounts, newsletters, discounts on courses, conferences etc and opportunities to participate in the development of the Trust.
